Undergraduate students currently at the Douglas, you are invited to submit an abstract to present at this event. It's a unique opportunity to present your research and to improve your presentation skills! **Your submission must include your name, level of study and name of your supervisor, as well as a summary of your research with a title, the list of authors and a description of your project (200 words max).** The presentation should include mostly research contributions of the undergraduate student.

The event will include two segments: a series of "blitz" talks (2 minutes, 2 slides max) and a discussion session in Zoom individual meeting rooms. There will be prizes for the best "blitz" talks (discussion sessions will not be judged)!

Please send your submission in Word format at douglas.academic.life@gmail.com by **Friday July 30th at 5:00pm** the latest, with "*Abstract for Undergraduate Expo*" as the email title. If you submit an abstract, please ensure to be available on August 17th between 3:30 and 5:00pm. Authors of selected abstracts will be notified in early August.
