Possible presentation topics include a proposed project idea, collected data, laboratory/statistical techniques, and other topics related to your research. **It does not need to be a finalized and well-polished study!** Applicants will be notified soon after the deadline whether they were selected to present.

As this event is designed with a focus for presentations by trainees, we welcome submissions from all students and postdocs of the research centre (research assistants are allowed to submit as well), and highly encourage attendance from PIs and staff alike!
